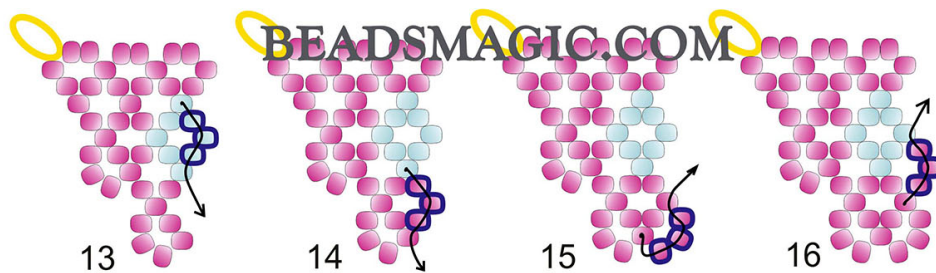
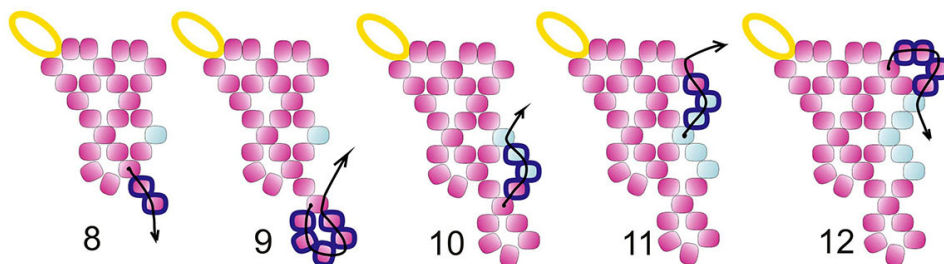
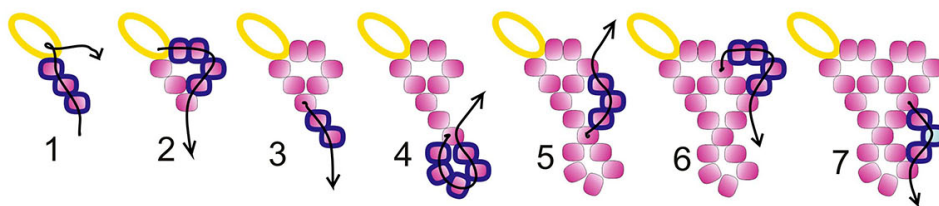
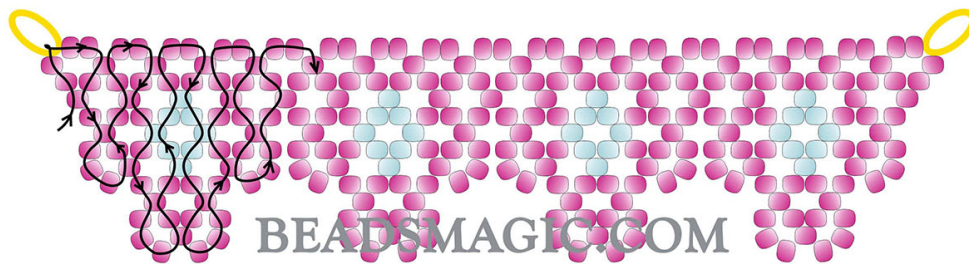
- seed beads 11/0

- clasp

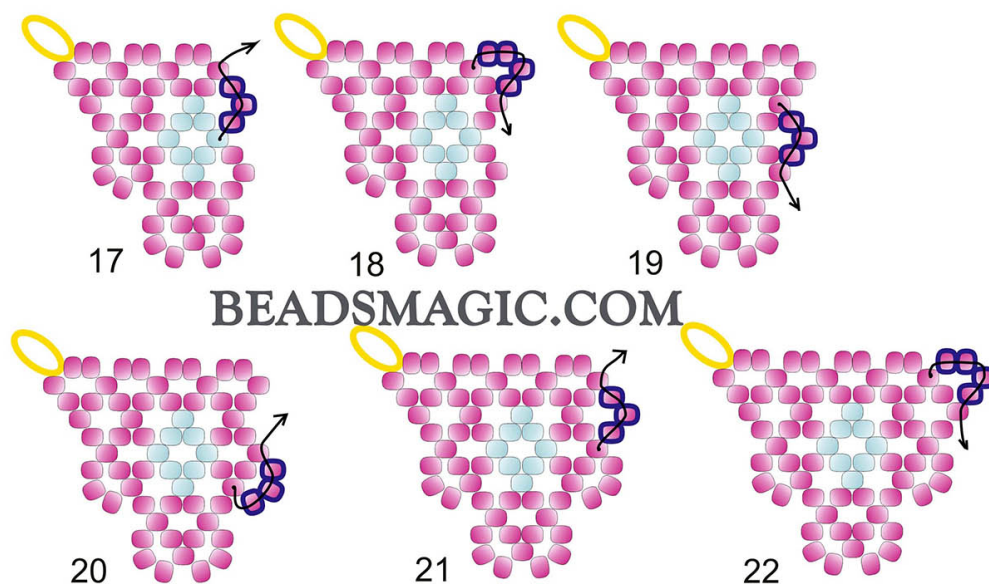

FREE PATTERN ROSALIND

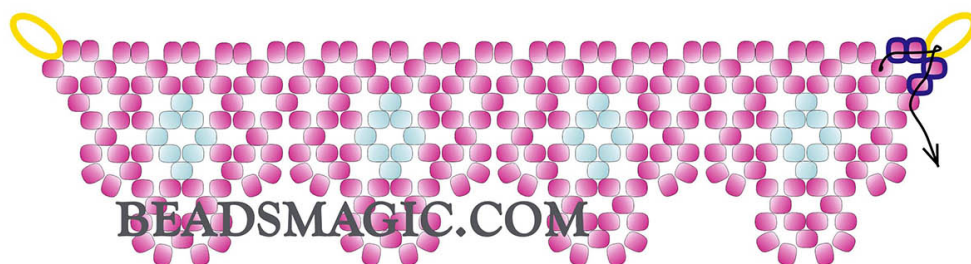
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After you finish step 22, repeat steps 3–22 again.
