

Free beading pattern for bracelet Amaranth

You can use our free beading pattern for bracelet Amaranth if u want to learn how to use Two-Needle Right Angle Weave or Crossweaving technique.

This is a light-weight and elegant cuff bracelet made from seed beads, bicones and and rounds beads. This classic design looks great with any colors. You can make it as with classis colors like silver or gold so with bright and unususal colors.



U need:

seed beads 11/0

bicone beads 4 mm

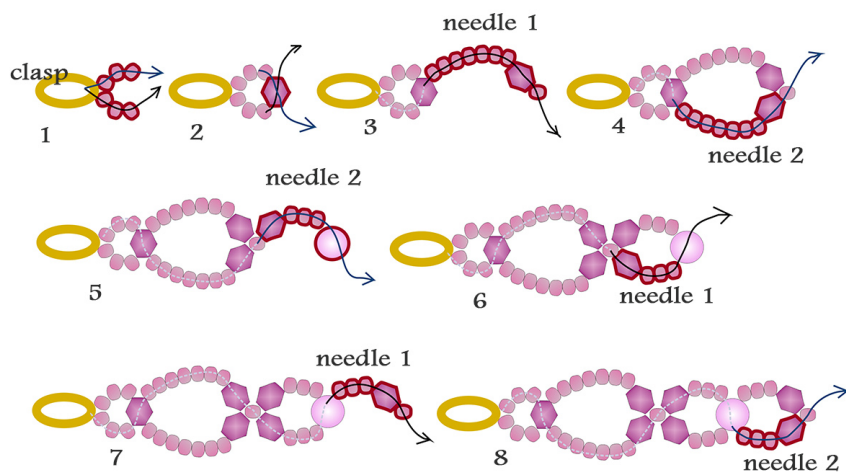
round or pearl beads 4 mm

U will use one thread and two needles on the ends of the thread.

Thread a needle onto each end of ca 4 feet of thread.

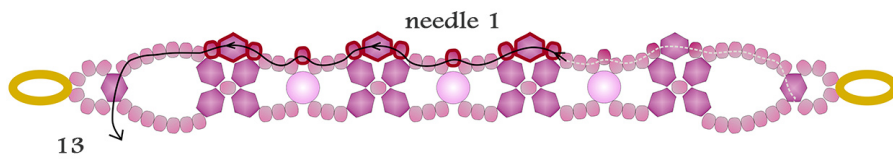
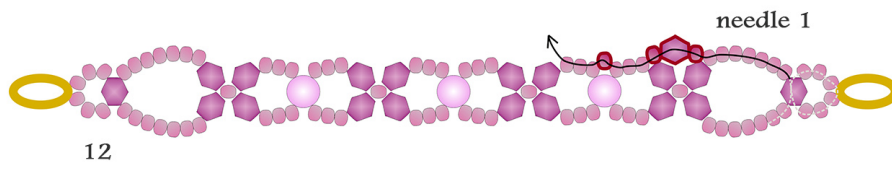


Repeat steps 5-8 to desired length (for exempale 8 times more).

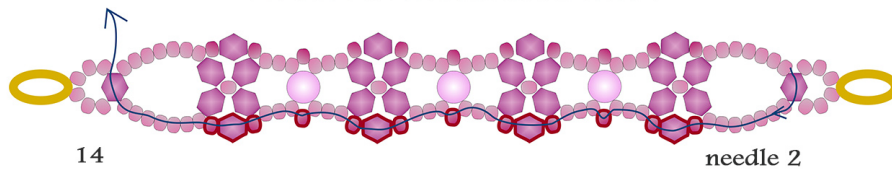
Then make steps 9-11 to attach the other part of the clasp.

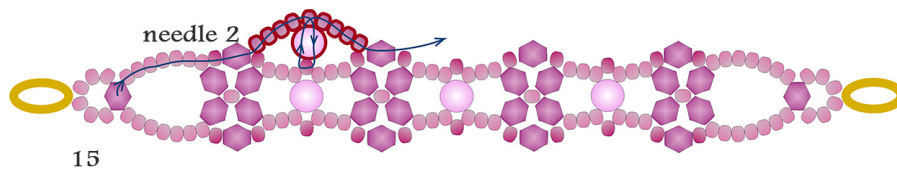


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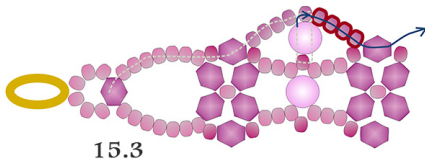
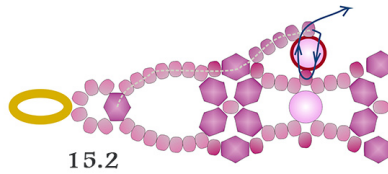
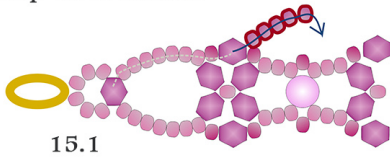


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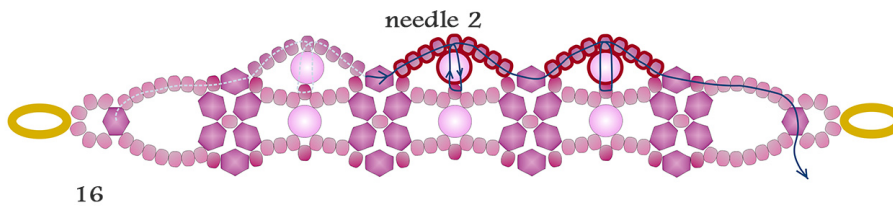


Step 15 in details:

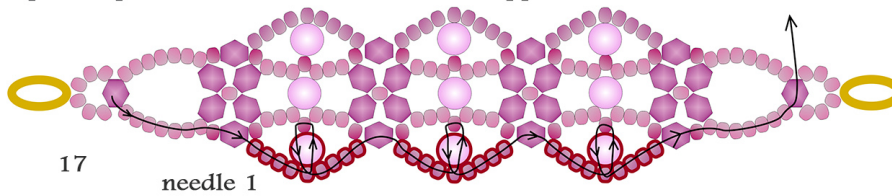


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Repeat step 15 till the end of the bracelet:
