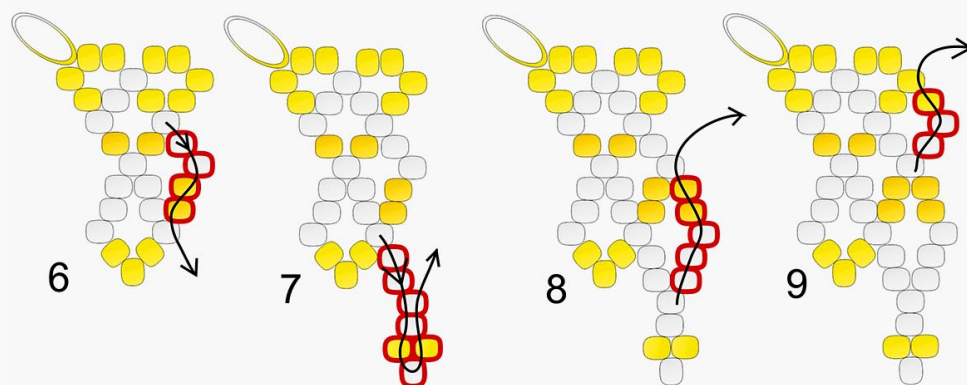
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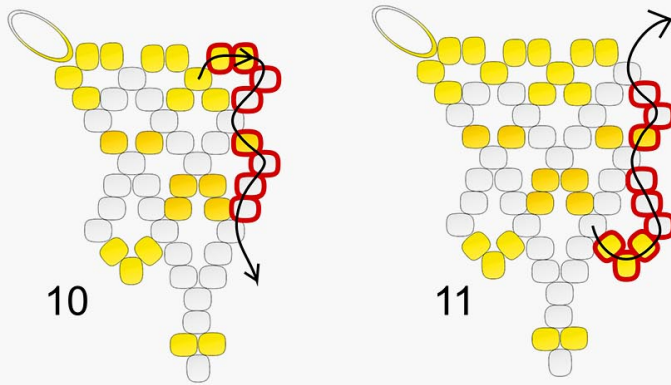
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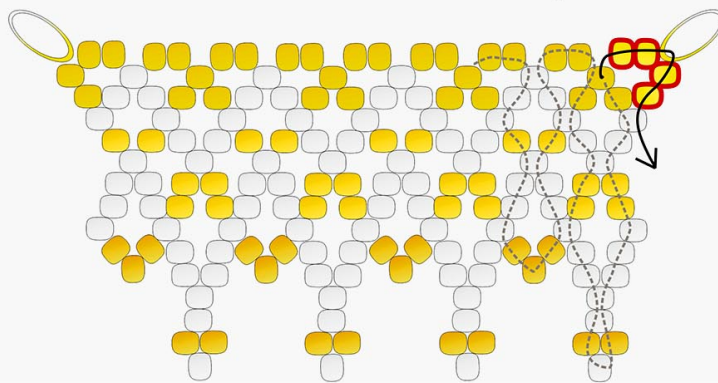


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After you finish Step 11, repeat Steps 5–11 until you reach the desired length of the necklace.
