Materials:

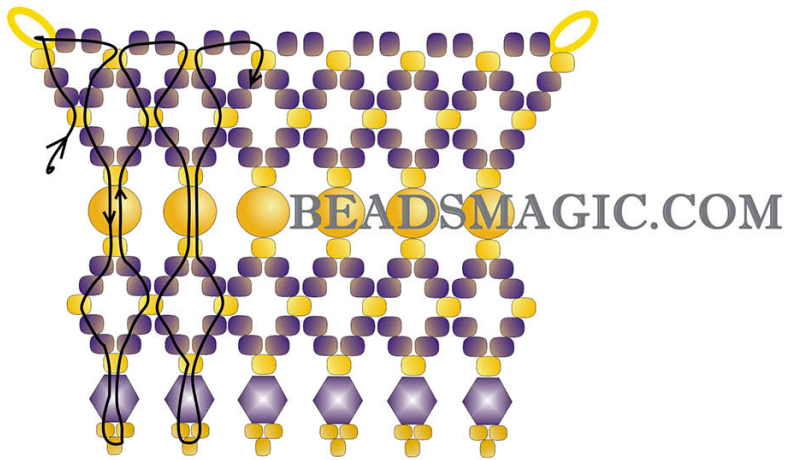
- Seed beads 11/0 (2 colors)
- Seed beads 15/= (1 color), you will use it on the steps 4 and 10
- round beads 4 or 6 mm
- bicone beads 4 or 6 mm
- beading thread for example Miyuki or fireline
- clasp

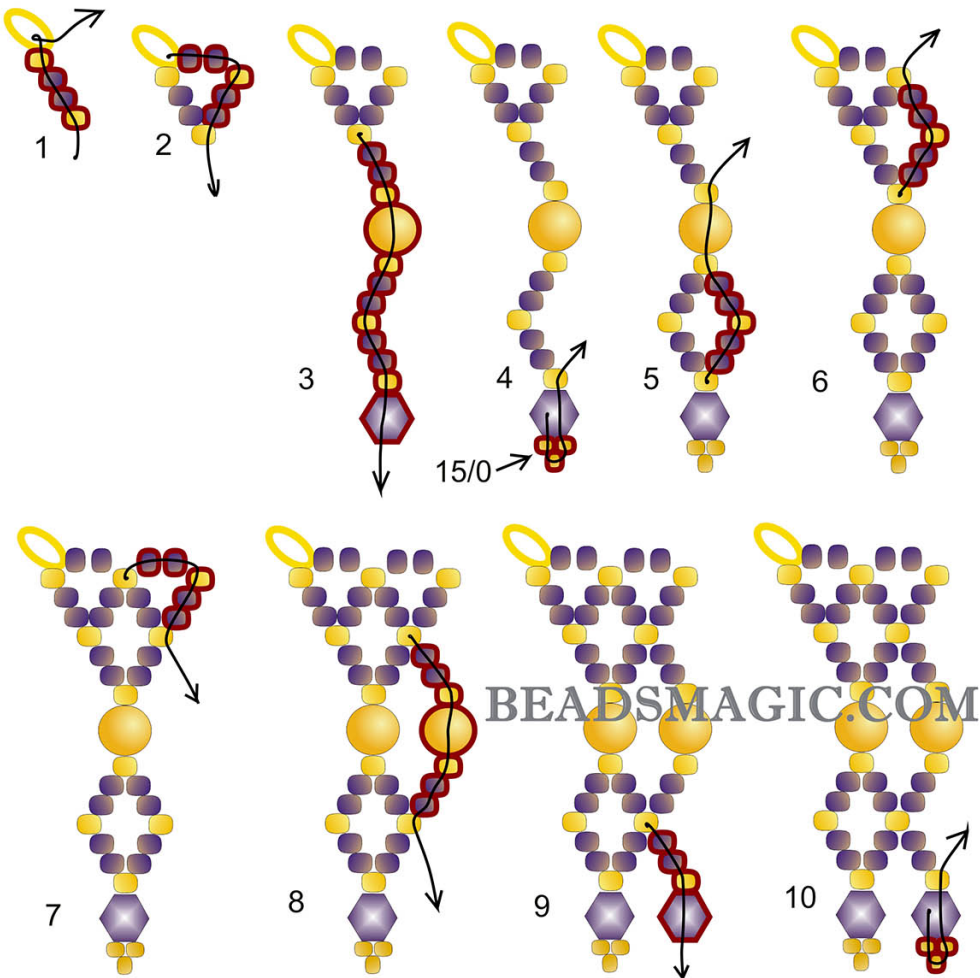

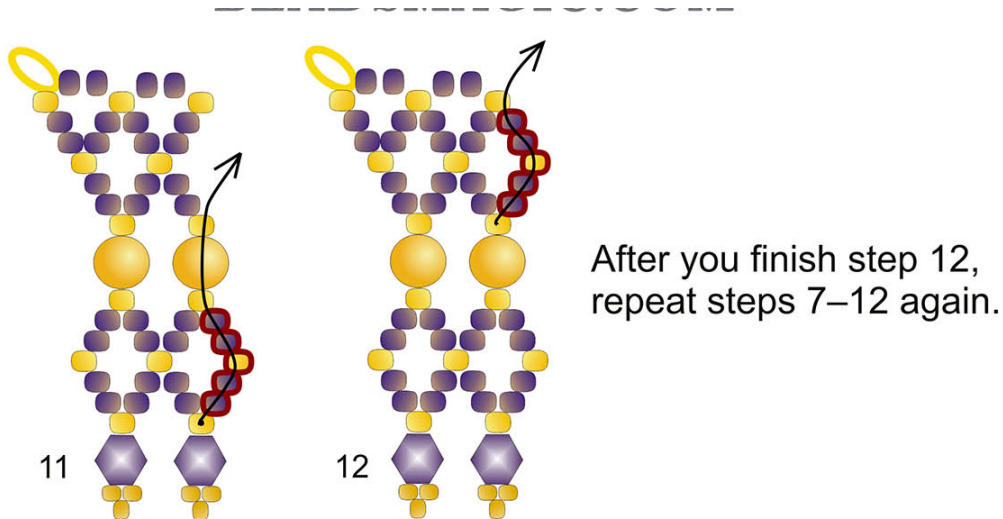

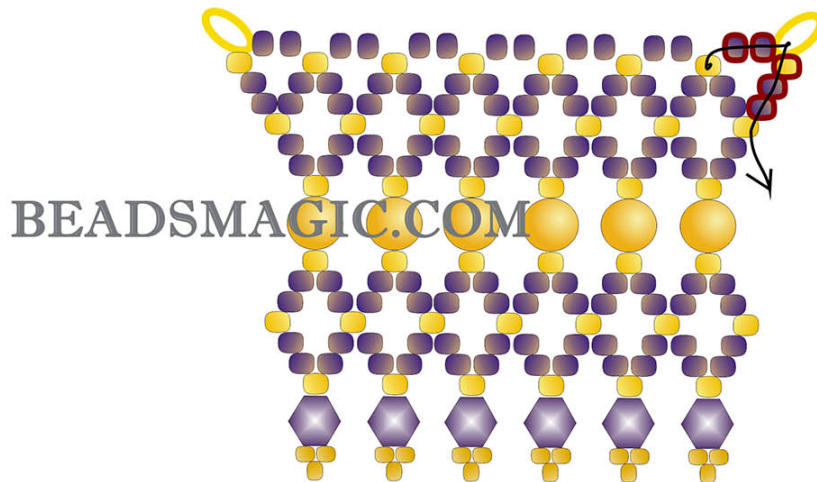
