seed beads 11/0

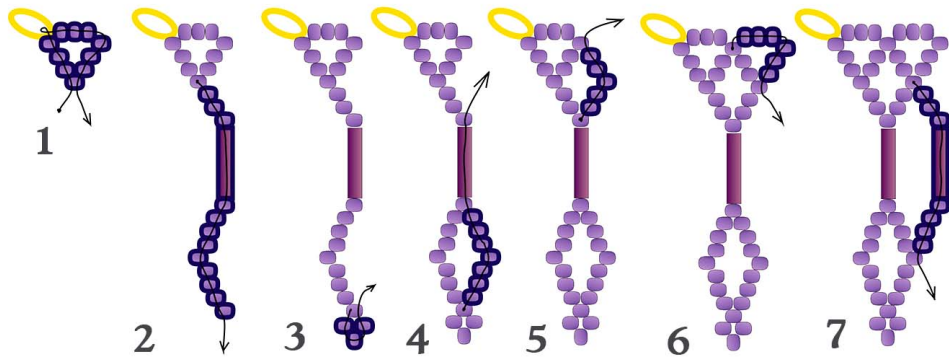
bugles 9 mm (can use any size available)

round beads 6 mm

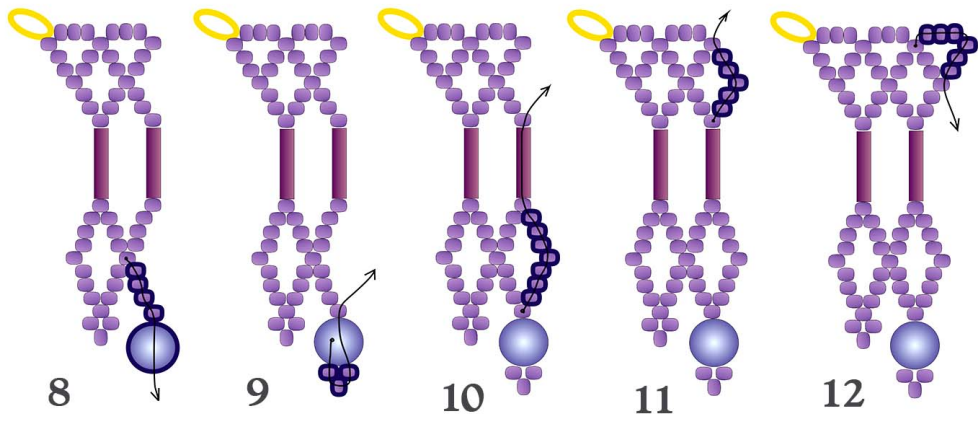

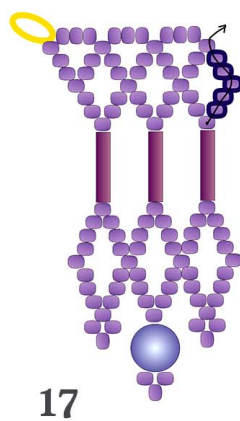
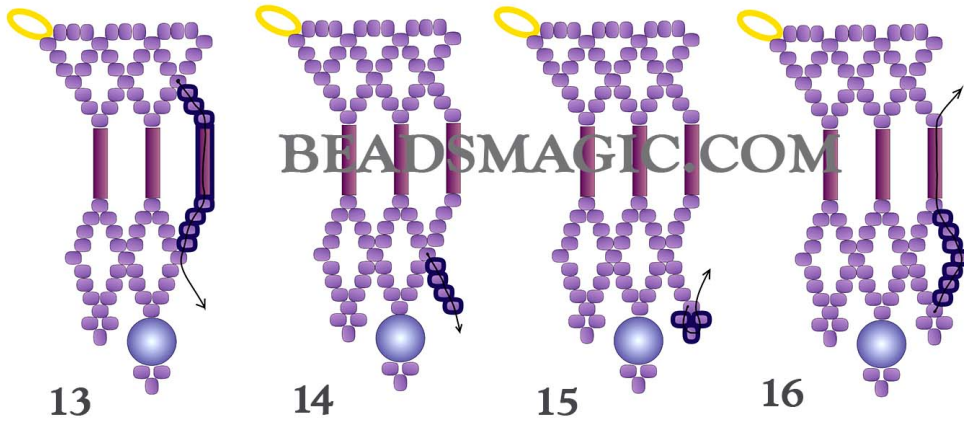
Click on the diagram to enlarge it.

Clasp



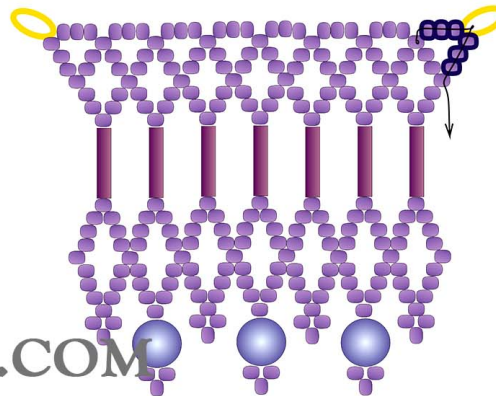
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After you finish step 17 repeat steps 6 -17 until the desired length.

Connect another part of the clasp in the end
